What to do if you are concerned or worried

If you believe that you, or someone that you know, is, or may be at risk of any form of abuse, OR you believe that you know someone who may pose a risk to others, then it is important to seek advice from a Safeguarding Adviser or Officer within the Church structure.

All policy and advisory documents are kept within the church and DBS checks are undertaken on all those who may have contact or connection with any vulnerable adult or child within the work of the church.

St Cuthbert's Church, Norham, is in Norham Deanery and is within the Diocese of Newcastle. The Diocesan Lead for Safeguarding team is Sharon Devlin, Director of Safeguarding. The Diocese provides and supervises regular training to all those in the parish and ensure that it is kept up to date.
